
Women's Bible Study

Stewardship Update & Financial Info

As pledges continue to come in to financially support the church's ministries in 2025, we are excited to share that 22 new households have made pledges totaling more than \$111,000, and 75 households have increased their annual



pledge amount by a total of more than \$71,000. It's exciting that so many are investing in significant new ways as our church is "Following Jesus to Flourishing Ministry" in 2025. Our pledges received for 2025 total over \$38,000 more than the pledges made for the current year. This will help the church manage increasing costs, expanding facility upkeep needs, and complex staffing decisions.

Our ministry commitments are dependent on every person's giving. If you have submitted a pledge, thank you! If you have not yet made a commitment, we hope you will prayerfully consider how you will be a part of supporting our church's ministries financially in the coming year. Per Capita

You can help offset FCPC's Per Capita assessment, paid to the presbytery based on church membership. This year our church will pay \$35,061, which represents \$38.11 per member. Your donation of \$38.11 can help offset this obligation. So far this year, \$2,305.11 has been donated to help cover FCPC's Per Capita amount.

New Giving System: PushPay

We will be transitioning from our current online giving platform (Shelby) to a new online giving platform called Pushpay in January.
