Congregational Meeting

JANUARY 5 / 10:40 AM / SANCTUARY

A congregational meeting will be held on Sunday, January 5, at 10:40am in the Sanctuary, to form an Associate Pastor Nominating Committee (APNC) and to elect an elder. Our current designated associate pastor, Rev. Rebecca DePoe, is serving our church for a designated time period that ends in September. The Session has approved a new job description for a future associate pastor and the Nominating Committee is prepared to nominate the following individuals to serve on the APNC to search for and identify a new associate pastor: Judy Grune, Mark Haas, Judy Leininger, Lynn Leppert, Jimmy Minor, Tim Oberlin, and Jaye Tupponce. In addition, the Nominating Committee is planning to nominate Amy Szlachetka for an open elder position with a two-year term.

FCPC was in a very different place in the fall of 2021 than it is today. The congregation was reeling from the exodus of three pastors, and a global pandemic. Both of which caused our church to question and reimagine who we are, and what God is calling us to be. Roger and I spent our first year of ministry together crafting a purpose and pathways statement and providing consistent, and inspiring (I hope!) leadership. Ginger joined the pastoral team in 2022, and the three of us reimagined the pastoral responsibilities going from three full time pastors to two.

Unlike when I started, the new associate pastor will inherit a fifty plus page playbook that outlines all the associate pastor job responsibilities. There will be clear systems in place for things like reimbursement requests, payroll, and a shared company drive. But most importantly, the new associate pastor will walk into a congregation that has been through adversity and come out the other side. And that other side includes excitement a clear sense of purpose in the types of ministry God has entrusted to our care.

As I write this, I'm not sure what the latter half of 2025 is going to look like for me. I'm not sure where I'll be working. If I'll be able to pass Economics as Business Strategy. Or what preschool my niece will be attending. But I do know that it has been the joy of my life to serve as your associate pastor. And I'm excited to see what God will do through us for the remainder of my designated term.




Women's Bible Study

Stewardship Update & Financial Info

As pledges continue to come in to financially support the church's ministries in 2025, we are excited to share that 22 new households have made pledges totaling more than \$111,000, and 75 households have increased their annual pledge amount



by a total of more than \$71,000. It's exciting that so many are investing in significant new ways as our church is "Following Jesus to Flourishing Ministry" in 2025. 2024 Reimbursements Due!



You can obtain expense request forms in the church office. If you are not sure how to fill out the form, please ask your committee chairperson to help you.

All 2024 pledge contributions, 2025 pledge prepayments or 2024 non-pledge contributions to FCPC must follow the deadlines below to be eligible for a 2024 tax deduction:

- Credit card donations must be made by midnight on December 31 in your time zone (your credit card statement must be time-stamped with a 2024 date).
- Check envelopes must be postmarked by USPS on or before December 31, 2024.
- Checks/cash must be dropped off at FCPC or put into the offering place by noon on December 31, 2024.
